Pandemic Volunteer Policy

Effective March 23 – May 31

***(In the interest of safety for all volunteers, core crew, and staff, Habitat for Humanity of Alamance County has adopted the following policy)***

- 1) The Pandemic Volunteer Policy will be posted on the website and at the build site.
- 2) All volunteers must register through the Affiliate Office (Ask for Cathy). No onsite registration.
- 3) Volunteers are limited to a maximum of 6 people per day. ***This is in addition to the construction staff and core crew.***
- 4) All volunteers must wear mask unless otherwise instructed by the Construction Supervisor. If you do not have a mask one will be provided for you.
- 5) All volunteers should hand sanitize frequently. Hand sanitizer will be provided.
- 6) All volunteers will have their temperature checked when arriving to the build site and answer screening questions.
- 7) All tools will be disinfected at the end of the build-day with sanitizing spray/wipe. We will provide sanitizing spray/wipe.
- 8) Group/Individual Volunteers may be cancelled/rescheduled, or this document may be altered at the discretion of the construction supervisor at any time due to the changing pandemic situations.
- 9) **Please stay home if you have any of the following symptoms (cough, fever, chills, loss of taste/smell). You will be able to reschedule.**



## BUILD SITE SCREENING QUESTIONS

- 1) Over the past 24 hours have you experienced any of the following symptoms? **(If yes, VOLUNTEER WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO VOLUNTEER TODAY!)**
  - a. Loss of taste or smell
  - b. Fever above 100 degrees
  - c. Sign of nausea, sore throat, headache, or cough
  - d. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing muscle pain, fatigue, or diarrhea.
- 2) Have you been in contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of or under investigation of COVID-19 in the past 14 days without wearing PPE? **(If yes, VOLUNTEER WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO VOLUNTEER TODAY!)**
- 3) Have you been living in the same home with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of or under investigation of COVID-19? **(If yes, VOLUNTEER WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO VOLUNTEER TODAY!)**
